

Expression of Interest (EOI)

Provision of ISO Certification Services to Staatsolie Maatschappij Suriname N.V.

Staatsolie Maatschappij Suriname N.V. (“Staatsolie”) hereby invites internationally accredited Certification Bodies to express their interest in providing **ISO management system certification services** for the upcoming certification cycle (2027 – 2023).

1. Objective of the Assignment

Staatsolie aims to engage a qualified, independent and globally recognized Certification Body to deliver certification and regular audit services for the following ISO standards:

- **ISO 9001 – Quality Management**
- **ISO 14001 – Environmental Management**
- **ISO 45001 – Occupational Health & Safety Management**
- **ISO 55001 – Asset Management**

The purpose of this engagement is to ensure continued compliance, assurance, and performance improvement across Staatsolie’s operational and supporting entities.

2. High-Level Scope of Services

The Certification Body will be responsible for:

- Conducting certification, surveillance and recertification audits.
- Evaluating Staatsolie’s management systems against the applicable ISO requirements.
- Providing audit reports, findings, and certificates issued under valid accreditation.
- Deploying competent, ISO-qualified auditors with relevant sector experience, preferably in Oil & Gas, Refining, Energy Generation, and upstream Operations.
- Executing audits on-site in Suriname, including all operational and support locations.
- Applying recognized audit methodologies and ensuring impartiality, consistency and audit quality.

3. Entities in Scope

The services will apply to multiple Staatsolie business units and sites, including but not limited to:

- **Upstream Operations**
- **Refinery & Power Plant**
- **Retail (GOw2)**
- **Staatsolie Power Company Suriname (SPCS)**
- **Corporate and functional departments**

4. Information Requested in the EOI

Interested Certification Bodies are invited to submit a short EOI that includes:

1. Company profile and accreditation details.
2. Relevant experience with the listed ISO standards, especially within the Oil & Gas or energy sector.
3. Geographical coverage, with explicit confirmation of capability to perform audits in Suriname.
4. Overview of audit methodology, quality assurance practices.
5. Indication of capacity and availability to support a multi-site audit program for the period 2027–2030.

5. Next Steps

Following the EOI evaluation, Staatsolie will shortlist eligible Certification Bodies and invite them to participate in the formal tendering process.
