

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST (REOI)
PILE DRIVING AND CONSTRUCTION OF EQUIPMENT FOUNDATIONS AT THE TA-58 CRUDE
TREATMENT PLANT STAATSOLIE MAATSCHAPPIJ N.V.

1. Introduction

Staatsolie Maatschappij Suriname N.V. ("the Employer") hereby invites eligible civil construction contractors, or associations/joint ventures of contractors, to submit Expressions of Interest (EOI) to prequalify for the execution of pile driving and equipment foundation works at the TA-58 Crude Treatment Plant in Suriname.

The works form part of project TA-58 expansion, to handle the forecast increase in fluid inflows, the TA-58 plant will be expanded with a new atmospheric CFWKO tank and associated equipment, for which new piled foundations are required.

2. Project Overview

The assignment covers the civil works for the construction of equipment foundations at the TA-58 Crude Treatment Plant, Dryland Operations. The works comprise piled foundations for the CFWKO-02 tank, the CFT-02 tank, and the WEMCO-04 and WEMCO-05 units, as well as modifications to the existing foundation of Skimtank 05.

The works are expected to include:

- Driving of approximately 71 precast concrete piles (section 40 x 40 cm, 2 x 20 m sections) to a minimum depth of 30 m or until rejection of the pile;
- Earthworks, including excavation at depths of 0 – 1.00 m and leveling of the site;
- Construction of reinforced concrete foundations (C30/37) for the CFWKO-02 tank, CFT-02 tank, and WEMCO-04 and WEMCO-05 units;
- Modifications to the existing Skimtank 05 foundation, including a cut-out for the clean-out nozzle and concreting of the existing sump;
- Supply and application of bitumen 60/70 sand for protection of the tank foundation bases.

The precast concrete piles will be supplied by Staatsolie.

Execution of the works is targeted for September – December 2026, with a duration of four (4) calendar months. The works will be executed within the operating TA-58 plant.

3. Scope of Works

The selected Contractor shall provide all services, materials, labor, tools, and equipment necessary for the handling, transportation, and execution of the works, including but not limited to:

- Site survey and verification of measurements as indicated in the specification drawings;
- Transport of the precast concrete piles from Staatsolie's stores to the project location;
- Earthworks: excavation at depths of 0 – 1.00 m for the foundations and leveling and

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raising of height where necessary;

- Driving of precast concrete piles under supervision, including pile driving records (stroke diagrams/calendar charts) for all piles;
- Concrete works: pouring of work floors and construction of reinforced concrete foundations (C30/37) in accordance with the construction drawings;
- Modifications to the existing Skimtank 05 foundation: cut-out for the clean-out nozzle and pouring of the existing sump with reinforced concrete, including chemical anchoring;
- Supply, transportation, and application of bitumen 60/70 sand (AASHTO M29-88) on the CFWKO-02 and CFT-02 tank foundations and the Skimtank 05 sump;
- Testing (concrete test cubes), an Inspection and Test Plan (ITP) with hold points, and redlining/as-built records.

All works shall be executed in accordance with the Terms of Reference, the construction drawings, Staatsolie's General Conditions of Contracting, and Staatsolie's HSE Contractor Management Procedures. The TA-58 plant will remain in normal operation during the execution of the works; safety and minimizing disruption to plant operations are of the highest priority.

4. Eligibility and Contractor Associations

Contractors may be:

- Civil construction contractors; or
- Associations, consortia, joint ventures, or sub-contracting arrangements thereof.

Contractors shall be registered as a supplier in Staatsolie's SAP Ariba system and shall have successfully executed projects within Staatsolie.

Where contractors associate with other firms, the nature of the association shall be clearly stated. Regardless of composition, the Contractor shall demonstrate that all resources necessary for the execution of the works are adequately covered.

5. Minimum Prequalification Requirements

Interested Contractors shall demonstrate:

- Legal eligibility and valid business registration;
- Registration as a supplier in Staatsolie's SAP Ariba system;
- Successful execution of previous projects within Staatsolie;
- Relevant experience with driving precast concrete piles and constructing reinforced concrete foundations;
- Availability of suitable pile driving rigs, equipment, and machinery for the works;
- Availability of qualified personnel in accordance with Staatsolie's minimum requirements for contractor personnel, including certified workers and an HSE Officer;
- HSE capability in accordance with Staatsolie's HSE Contractor Management Procedures;
- Adequate financial capacity to execute the works.

Experience with civil works at operating oil and gas facilities is considered an advantage.

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6. Submission Requirements for Prequalification

Interested Contractors shall submit the following information, structured into formal and technical submissions.

A. Formal Submission Requirements

Interested Contractors shall submit the following administrative and compliance documentation:

- Letter of Interest signed by an authorized representative;
- Company legal registration and corporate information;
- Proof of registration in Staatsolie's SAP Ariba system;
- Joint venture/association information (if applicable), including identification of members and lead firm;
- Financial information demonstrating sufficient capacity to execute the works;
- Declaration of integrity and compliance, confirming that neither the Contractor nor the firms it shall associate with for this assignment, nor their directors, officers, employees, or affiliated entities has been involved in or convicted of participation in a criminal organization, bribery, corruption, fraud, terrorist offences or financing, money laundering, child labor, or human trafficking. The Contractor shall confirm compliance with applicable laws and ethical standards, commit to full disclosure of any relevant circumstances, and may provide details of remedial or self-cleaning measures where applicable.

B. Technical and Material Submission Requirements

Interested Contractors shall submit the following technical and qualification information:

- 1 General company experience summary demonstrating capability relevant to pile driving and reinforced concrete foundation works;
- 2 Portfolio of comparable projects completed within the past five (5) years, including projects executed within Staatsolie, with completion evidence;
- 3 Organization chart and proposed project team with qualifications and certifications of key personnel;
- 4 List of available pile driving rigs, equipment, and machinery;
- 5 Outline project execution approach and indicative schedule for the works;
- 6 Client references and completion certificates for comparable works.

7. Shortlisting

Expressions of Interest will first be assessed under Part A on a pass/fail basis against the formal submission requirements. Only submissions that 100% satisfy Part A will proceed to Part B, where they will be evaluated in accordance with the weighted criteria set out below.

Only Contractors that achieve a Pass under Part A and attain a minimum score of 80 points out of 100 under Part B shall be eligible for shortlisting and may be invited to participate in the subsequent Request for Proposals (RFP) stage.

The successful Contractor will ultimately be selected from the subsequent RFP shortlist based on quality, compliance, technical capability, schedule, risk, and price.

The Employer reserves the right to:

- accept or reject any Expression of Interest;
- request clarifications or additional information;
- shortlist any number of contractors;
- cancel or modify the procurement process at any stage for due reason and without incurring any liability.
