1. Introduction

Interested suppliers may submit an Expression of Interest for one or both (i) and /or (ii), subject to demonstrate capability, relevant experience, and an appropriate product portfolio.

This EOI forms part of the prequalification process and is intended to establish a shortlist of qualified suppliers who may be invited to participate in a subsequent competitive tender process.

<p>Framework Agreement for the Supply of Commodity and Speciality Chemicals</p>	<p>The Supplier under the framework agreement shall:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Supply commodity and specialty chemicals in accordance with agreed specifications, approved brands, and fixed unit prices. • Ensure continuous product availability and supply continuity to support Staatsolie’s operational requirements and those of its contractors; • Deliver products to designated locations, including contractor sites, warehouses, and distribution hubs, in accordance with agreed delivery schedules and lead times • Demonstrate and maintain adequate storage facilities, including appropriate warehousing conditions for chemical and hygiene products, in compliance with applicable standards and regulations • Ensure proper handling, storage, and transportation of products, including adherence to safety, environmental, and regulatory requirements • Comply with all applicable Health, Safety and Environment (HSE) standards and maintain relevant certifications where applicable • Implement robust quality assurance and quality control processes, including product inspection, traceability (batch/lot tracking), and proper labeling in line with regulatory requirement • Ensure that all products supplied are accompanied by required documentation, such as Safety Data Sheets (SDS), where applicable • Demonstrate sufficient organizational capacity, including qualified personnel to support logistics, QA/QC, and supply chain activities • Maintain effective inventory management and replenishment processes to ensure optimal stock levels and avoid supply disruptions • Maximising local content in all activities contributing to local content objectives, including but not limited to: use of local labour and subcontractors where feasible, in-country warehousing and logistics capabilities, technology transfer and capacity building initiatives, Joint Ventures or teaming arrangements with locally registered businesses.

4. Eligibility and Supplier Associations

Suppliers may be:

- Local firms registered in Suriname or
- International firms;

Where suppliers associate with other firms, the nature of the association shall be clearly stated.

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5. Minimum Prequalification Requirements

Expressions of Interest submissions will be evaluated in accordance with the weighted criteria set out below.
